GENERAL NOTES:

Additional reporting measures were introduced in 2009 due to the introduction of Capital Asset Management Accounting for Municipalities.

Due to the 2005 Boundary Adjustment, population and household numbers decreased for 2006. Accordingly, measures that use population or household in the denominator may have increased in 2006 due to this change.
