

**Boil Water Advisory**  
**Hickson Public Water System**  
**(Serving the King Subdivision)**  
**East Zorra-Tavistock Township, ON**

Due to unsatisfactory results from recent bacteriological tests on this water supply, Public Health and Emergency Services **advises you to not drink this water.**

You are advised **to boil your drinking water or use bottled water** for drinking until the sample results confirm the bacteriological safety of the water. Once the water sample results confirm that the supply is safe again, you will be notified.

Bring water to a rolling boil for one (1) minute. It may then be stored and cooled in clean containers. **Boiled or bottled water** should be used for drinking, making infant formula, washing raw fruits and vegetables and brushing teeth.

**OR**

Mix ¼ tsp. (1.25 ml) of liquid household bleach, such as Javex, to one gallon (4.5 litres) of water and let stand for 30 minutes. There should be a faint chlorine smell to the water. Store boiled or treated water in clean containers in the refrigerator.
