- * Constant flow with no icing or red line
- * Penalty shots to be taken at the end of the game. This promotes a constant flow to the game and no standing around to watch penalty shots during game time.
- * It also creates an exciting way to finish off each session for every age group
- * Shifts will be 75 seconds in length allowing for full one minute shifts after a change
- * Carded referees for every game played
- * Every team will have 16 players - 15 skaters and 1 goalie.
- * Goalie and player equipment will not be supplied
- * Goalie position is for the duration of the season
- * Detailed rules provided for all at the first game of the season HHTD Philosophy for Summer Hockey
