

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Tavistock wastewater treatment plant

To Present the Findings of the County's Review of Alternatives

Oxford County has been planning the upgrade and expansion of Tavistock's wastewater treatment plant following the Class Environmental Assessment process.

A Hearing of Necessity Inquiry was held under the Expropriations Act on June 25, 2009 at the request of the owners of the land in question. The Inquiry Officer's report recommended that the County review the decision to expand and upgrade the existing lagoon system and further consider the option of constructing a mechanical plant.

County Council on August 12, 2009 directed Public Works Department staff to undertake the recommended review. A Public Information Meeting was held on September 2, 2009 to present the work plan that the County would be undertaking in response to County Council's direction.
