About Tavistock's wastewater treatment system expansion

Oxford County is in the process of upgrading and expanding Tavistock's existing lagoon-based wastewater treatment system. We believe this is the best option for the community at this time.

The upgrade/expansion project is designed to meet Tavistock's projected growth for the next 20 years. It also offers a number of advantages that meet the unique needs of the community. For the citizens of Tavistock, it comes at a moderate increase to yearly wastewater fees, much less than the cost of a mechanical plant, which could raise those fees by almost 500%.
