Notice is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the

Nominations in the Township of East Zorra-Tavistock for the offices listed above may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council, and \$100 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, certified cheque or debit.

A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent during regular business hours between May 1, 2026, and August 20, 2026, and between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on August 21, 2026 (Nomination Day).

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only on Wednesday, August 26, 2026, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Individuals seeking nomination for municipal office are responsible for ensuring they are familiar with and comply with the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. This

includes, but is not limited to, rules related to eligibility, nominations, campaign financing, and election conduct. Candidates are encouraged to review the legislation and any applicable guidance materials to fully understand their obligations throughout the nomination and election process.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened on the dates stated below for the purpose of voting.

Advance Voting Period: October 13, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. and run until October 25, 2026
Voting Day: October 26, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until the close of polls at 8:00 p.m.
